# Scomi bags US\$71.4m oilfield services jobs

Orders secured in first five months of 2015 despite softening drilling market

KUALA LUMPUR: Scomi Energy Services Bhd's oilfield services division has secured US\$71.4 million (RM267.04 million) worth of contracts in the first five months of 2015, despite the easing of drilling activities in many markets, bringing its current order book to over RM4 billion.

The new contracts secured this year are from about US\$980 million worth of bids submitted so far, Scomi (fundamental: 1; valuation: 0.5) said in a statement yesterday.

"We are encouraged by this development, despite the easing of drilling activities in many markets.

"We have been focusing on delivering the right solutions and service quality to our clients, and we believe these are the main reasons for our success in this challenging environment," said Wan Ruzlan Iskandar, president of the market units and oilfield services division.

Orders from Oman and Thailand drew US\$33 million each, while the balance came in from Australia, Indonesia, Russia and Pakistan.

The contracts involve the provision of drilling waste management equipment and services as well as drilling fluids solutions to clients in the Middle East, Asia-Pacific and Europe, the statement read.

Looking ahead, the company

remains optimistic that the results of other tenders will be positive, especially in its core markets of Myanmar and Indonesia.

Scomi's stock price has been trending downwards in tandem with the oil price rout last year. From RM1.06 on July 30 last year, it has fallen about 65% to 37 sen yesterday, up 1.5 sen from Wednesday's close.


Due to the long-term nature of its contracts, Scomi weathered

Revenue for the financial year under review ended March 31, 2015 rose 8.8% to RM1.8 billion from RM1.65 billion the previous year.
